

SPECIAL MEETING
CITY OF ONIDA
09/18/2017

The Onida City Council met on September 18th, 2017 at 7:30 p.m. in the Onida City Office with Mayor Gary Wickersham presiding. Council members present were: LaJena Gruis, Jennifer Kenzy-Soderholm, Joel Miller, Marla Mosiman, and Bob Porter. Others present: Weldon Stephens and Sheila Ring.

VARIANCE PROCEDURES: Attorney Sovell emailed a new Variance and Procedures form to the Council for their consideration. With Sovell's correspondence, she did state that she had done research and a rereading of our ordinances and her thoughts are that with the camp ground requests that are coming in, it would be far easier for people to make an application for a variance. With that being stated, motion was made by Gruis seconded by Kenzy-Soderholm to approve the new Variance request form. All ayes. Motion carried.

Council directed Hiller to request Sovell to send letters to people that already have campers in place that have not come in for approval.
