

SPECIAL MEETING
CITY OF ONIDA
06/10/2019

The Onida City Council met on Monday, June 10th, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor Gary Wickersham presiding. Present at Roll Call: LaJena Gruis, Brooke Jacquot, Marla Mosiman, Jane Pitlick and Caleb Shepherd. Also present: Sheila Ring, Tyce Meyer, Ben Minihan, Milt Hancock, Ken Barber and Jerry Rausch.

The purpose of this meeting was to address the variance and street vacate requested by CHS Midwest Cooperative. Mr. Hancock explained to the Council what the intent is for the company with several questions being asked by the Council for clarification. Both the variance and vacate were published notices in the Onida Watchman.

Motion to reenter City Council at 6:20 p.m. by Gruis seconded by Pitlick. All ayes. Motion carried.

ARRIVAL: Justin Mennenger arrived at 6:25 p.m.

BUILDING PERMITS:

CHS Midwest Cooperative – 305 Cedar Avenue – two (2) 1 million gallon storage tanks and ten (10) 30,000 gallon storage tanks and two (2) 40 x 8 steel containers, and build a load out facility. Motion by Pitlick seconded by Gruis to approve permit. All ayes. Motion carried.

Ken Barber – 123 South Main Street – two (2) 16 x 40 steel container office buildings. Motion by Pitlick seconded by Jacquot to approve permit. Ayes: Jacquot, Mennenger, Pitlick and Shepherd. Nays: Gruis and Mosiman. Motion carried.

POOL: Pitlick brought a couple of pictures of picnic tables to place in the splash park area. Motion by Mosiman seconded by Shepherd to approve the purchase of two (2) tables. Roll Call: All ayes. Motion carried.

OTHER: Jerry Rausch voiced his concerns about out problem street lights. This was brought up at the June 3rd, 2019 meeting in which Council instructed Tim Gruis to work on a solution to the problem.

A cover for the baseball field bleachers was discussed. Lajena Gruis will work on this project.
