

SPECIAL MEETING

The Onida City Council held a special meeting on Tuesday, October 15th, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Gary Wickersham presiding. Present at Roll Call: LaJena Gruis, Justin Mennenger, Marla Mosiman, Jane Pitlick and Caleb Shepherd. Also present: Tim Gruis.

EQUIPMENT PURCHASE: The reason for this special meeting was to discuss a loader purchase for the City of Onida. We have been in discussions with Case and John Deere. Both have had representatives here to discuss with the Council their machines. It was even money for the initial purchase of the machines but thoughts are that with the warranty coverage with Case and the better fuel mileage it would cost us around \$5000.00 less per year to run the Case loader. The machines were tried out by Jost and Gruis and they stated that they liked certain aspects of both machines. Gruis stated that he plans to stay on with the City and that he would like to keep better equipment on hand but also stated that he does not see the need to switch out equipment every three years. Motion by Shepherd seconded by Gruis to purchase the Case loader with no balloon payment. Roll Call: All ayes. Motion carried. Absent: Jacquot. Hiller was asked to check with BankWest and Sunrise Bank to see if they could beat or match the financing option from Case.
