The Onida City Council met on Monday, December 2nd, 2019 at 7:30 p.m. in the City Office with President Marla Mosiman presiding. Present at Roll Call: LaJena Gruis, Brooke Jacquot, Jane Pitlick and Caleb Shepherd. Also present: Tim Jost, Tim Gruis, Sheila Ring, Emily Sovell, Casey Hight and Bill Stahl.

MINUTES: Motion by Pitlick seconded by Shepherd to approve the minutes from the November 4th, 2019 City Council meeting. All ayes. Motion carried.
