

CONTINUING RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-01

WHEREAS, the legislature of the State of South Dakota has granted to the governing body of a municipality of the State of South Dakota the authority to regulate certain aspects of liquor licensing; and;

WHEREAS, SDCL 35-4-11, allows the governing body of a municipality to adopt a continuing resolution determining the number of on-sale and off-sale licenses it will approve and the fees to be charged for the various classifications of licenses pursuant to SDCL 35-4-2; and

WHEREAS, the maximum number of on-sale licenses issued inside municipalities are based upon the population of the municipality. However, the maximum allowable licenses need not be the number which the governing body of the municipality need authorize; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Onida City Council that they shall approve a maximum of three (3) on-sale licenses inside the municipality; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Onida City Council that they shall approve a maximum of two (2) off-sale licenses inside the municipality, making zero (0) additional licenses available for issuance August 2nd, and

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED by the Onida City Council that the fee for issuance of a new on-sale license shall be \$1500.00;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Onida City Council that the fee for issuance of a new off-sale license shall be \$2500.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Onida City Council that the renewal fee for all classes of alcoholic beverages issued or approved by the City of Onida shall be at the maximum fee allowed by SDCL 35-4-2; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Onida City Council that this Continuing Resolution shall be effective August 2nd, 2021 and continue in effect until repealed by the passage of a new Continuing Resolution on the same subject.
