ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ONIDA, SOUTH DAKOTA
ESTABLISHING LICENSE COSTS FOR TEMPORARY MALT BEVERAGE LICENSE
AND TEMPORARY LIQUOR LICENSES

WHEREAS, pursuant to South Dakota Law, the City of Onida, South Dakota, shall establish rules for regulating and restricting the issuance of special licenses for temporary malt beverage and temporary liquor licenses and;

WHEREAS, The City of Onida, South Dakota, wishes to comply with state law concerning operation of the special licenses;

NOW, THEREFOR, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Onida, South Dakota, as follows:

- A. Temporary malt beverage licenses for civic, charitable, educational, fraternal or veterans organizations may be issued to said group at a cost of \$50.00 per day.
~~Temporary liquor license are not to be issued to such groups;~~
- B. Temporary malt beverage licenses may be issued to any licensee holding a malt beverage or on-sale alcoholic beverage license located within the City of Onida at a cost of \$50.00 per day;
- C. Temporary liquor licenses may be issued to any licensee holding a malt beverage or on-sale alcoholic beverage license in the City of Onida at a cost of \$150.00 per day.
- D. Each above-described license shall not exceed three consecutive days in length;
- E. That the licensee must comply with all applicable state laws concerning the consumption of alcoholic beverages as set forth in SDCL ch. 35-4
- F. If the applicant already holds an on-sale alcoholic beverage or a malt beverage license or if the license is to be used in a publicly owned facility, it is not necessary to have a hearing on the temporary application and the number of licenses that may be issued to any licensee or organization in any calendar year is five.
- G. A violation of this section is punishable by thirty (30) days imprisonment in a county jail or a five hundred dollar (\$500.00) fine, or both.
